Dear Parent/Carer

Thank you to everyone who responded to our Parent Survey. The Trust Board have reviewed all answers and comments received.

- The vast majority of feedback was very positive about Fareham Academy's remote learning provision in 2021 and communication concerning the pandemic. The majority of parents felt that the volume of work expected was just right and of acceptable to high quality. This is testament to the hard work of all staff who have had to establish new ways of working over the last year.
- Over 81% of parents felt their children were happy at Fareham Academy and would recommend Fareham Academy to another parent.
- A small minority of parents highlighted concerns regarding behaviour and we would like to reassure you that staff are working hard to minimise disruptions to lessons as a result of unacceptable behaviour. We would encourage all parents to work with staff to stress the importance of meeting our behaviour standard. This ensures all children access educational opportunities fully. The survey results support that the majority of children do however present a high standard of behaviour.
- Parents felt well informed about behaviour with the help of the Class Chart system, however questioned the consistency of how points were awarded. We can assure you that the Academy is looking into ways to improve this as we recognise that students do value the system and we want to capitalise on its impact fairly. The Academy will look to engage parents through its Face to Face sessions on this subject in the new academic year.
- Nearly 90% of parents felt their children were taught well at Fareham Academy, however only 80% reported their child making good progress. The Trust Board and the Academy are striving to unlock the potential in every child by offering a broad and balance curriculum whilst appreciating all children are diverse with varying appetites for learning. Progress will continue to be a priority and monitored by the Trust Board. The trust will seek further feedback on this matter in its next parent survey.
- We would like to remind all Parents about the fantastic [Student Support Services Team](#) at Fareham Academy and be reassured that the strong pastoral team will support your children throughout their time at the school.
- Fareham Academy has high expectations in relation to uniform and often shares uniform abiding parent's frustration when some students continue to flaunt the rules. The Academy understands the impact of the last 18 months and will continue to work with parents and carers to ensure standards of uniform are applied consistently for all.
